3. Use of lifting equipment, manhole lifter, tripod personnel and/or lifting equipment, use of hand, hydraulic, mechanical and engine driven power tools.
4. Use of suction, collection and pumping equipment.
5. Use of steps, ladders, scaffolding, powered/manual platforms and other means of access or egress.
6. Use of harness and lanyards for access and egress to manholes access, elevated heights, controlled use of breathing apertures in confined spaces.
7. Removal of rubbish and disposal of liquid and solid waste.
8. Use of cutting, bending, concrete cutting and excavation equipment
9. Use of hand tools for plumbing purpose
10. Use of cctv equipment to record internal areas of drains
